

THE HIGHEST MOUNTAINS 1962-1967

THIS list of first ascents of peaks over 23,000 ft. in height is a continuation of previous lists published in *A. J.* 62. 165, 64. 136, and 66. 391.

Where accounts exist a reference for each ascent has been given in the *Alpine Journal* or the *Himalayan Journal*. In some cases references have been given to Dr. G. O. Dyhrenfurth's 'Chronique Himalayenne' in *Les Alpes*, where further references to the various ascents may be found.

In the last few years the heights of a number of peaks have been changed as a result of recent surveys. In the Hindu Kush three peaks previously rated as over 23,000 ft. have been down-graded. They are Tirich Mir Nord, Nadir Shah, and Koh-i-Kishmi Khan. A fourth peak, Languta-Barfi, has been down-graded from its status as a 7000 m. peak, but it was never ranked as being over 23,000 ft. (7000 m. = 22,966 ft.).

Mention may also be made of Pik Dostuk, the East Peak of Pik Pobeda in the Tien Shan, whose height is 7003 m.; it thus falls short by 24 ft. of being a 23,000 ft. peak.
